1. Opening

The THD Program Committee Meeting was called to order by Bill Cheung at 03:08 p.m.

The meeting minutes from November 2004 meeting at Washington DC were approved without further comment.

4. Action Items from June 2004 Meeting

a. NURETH-11 registration fee

It was reported that as a result of the THD committee's effort that new registration fee structure was adapted by the NURETH-11. Bob Martin had drafted letter to NURETH-11 organizers. A positive response was received from NURETH-11. The current registration fee for ANS members is 550-Euro until June 30 and after June 30 the fee is 650 Euro. This is against regular registration of 700 and 800 Euro respectively.

b. NURETH-12

The Screening committee has studied the proposal for NURETH-12 by ANS Pittsburgh section. A formal evaluation was done using NURETH criteria with a score of 8.6/10. The screening committee has drafted a letter to the Executive

Committee. ExecutiveCommittee feedback to the organizers is expected. Our division member Kurshad Muftuoglu is working hard on the planning and organization.

5. 2005 ANS Winter Meeting Program

Larry Hochreiter is working on a panel session on 10CFR50.46 revisions. He is planning on panel members from NRC, Westinghouse, Framatome, and Penn State. The status of the 10CFR50.46 revisions is currently under consideration by NRC Commissioners.

Bob Martin suggested that as a part of committee performance evaluation, professional development activities such as workshop, educational courses or training camps are important. An adhoc committee was setup to explore the possibility of arranging such workshops. The members of the adhoc committee are Bob Martin, Joy Rempe, Karen Vierow and Kune Suh.

5d Thermal Hydraulics: Computational Fluid Dynamics and Heat Transfer (Yassin Hassan, Hisashi Ninokata)

5e Severe Accident Code Development and Applications (Joy Rempe, Karen Vierow)
